T KLWM WE ARDENTLY LOVE the pure Syrahs of the northern Rhône. We think it is the greatest, most diverse collection of *terroirs* for Syrah in the world, and despite the miniscule acreage, the prices remain more than correct. Everyone knows by now that 2007 was a fabulous vintage in the Rhône Valley and certainly not one to be missed from these top addresses.

DOMAINE CLAPE

Three generations of Clapes continue their tradition in Cornas with great pride. Vintage 2007 at Cornas offers depth, concentration, and fine tannins. This is true Cornas at its best. It also tastes of integrity, a Clape trademark. Kermit brings in ancient Clapes once in a while from the '70s and '80s—to "educate the staff," as he puts it—and what an education. The wine also shows timelessness—what was, still is.

THIERRY ALLEMAND

BEAUJOLAIS

2008 MORGON "CÔTE DU PY" JEAN FOILLARD

Every year Foillard brings us a flawless Côte du Py, always one of the best three or four Beaujolais of the vintage. The purity and sensuality of a Foillard Morgon is a beautiful thing to behold. If this wine doesn't convert the most die-hard of anti-Beaujolais fanatics, nothing will, and if it doesn't, well, I pity their ungrateful leaden palates. A handful of vignerons represent a pendulum swing countering the gallons of plonk that have damaged the reputation of a major wine region. But we ask only that you try our producers' wines for their undeniable deliciousness.

2007 MORGON "CUVÉE MARCEL LAPIERRE" MARCEL LAPIERRE

Marcel, our fearless leader in Morgon, produces a small quantity of this special cuvée, but so far only in certain vintages. It is from his oldest vines (over one hundred years), mostly from the Côte du Py, aged longer, and released later than the domaine's flagship Morgon bottling. This is a more serious, more structured, more intense expression of the Morgon *terroir*, and it needs a few years in the bottle or an hour in a decanter to get its mojo working.

2008 CÔTE-DE-BROUILLY • NICOLE CHANRION

I can't speak highly enough about the indefatigable Nicole Chanrion and her fabulous Beaujolais. One of the things we value at KLWM is consistency, and Nicole has proven over the years that she knows what it takes to put a great wine in bottle every year, regardless of the vagaries of Mother Nature. She finds a way. The 2008 is a masterpiece, a more statuesque Côte-de-Brouilly than the comparatively delicate 2007. Gamay grown in the blue granite of this Côte ages well, too, really well. I always put down extra bottles to age after I enjoy the new bounty. With age a Rhône-like spiciness emerges.

BURGUNDY

2007 BOURGOGNE PASSETOUTGRAIN DOMAINE ROBERT CHEVILLON

I love the way this wine combines the qualities we search for in good Beaujolais and good red Burgundy. You'll find the unpretentious, hedonistic Gamay fruit and the more refined, more discreet pleasure of Burgundian Pinot Noir. The blend is a wine easy enough to enjoy at any moment with or without food and at the same time a wine serious enough to pair with hearty dishes like *coq au vin*, *boeuf bourguignon*, or wild game birds. It offers the best of both worlds, and lest you've forgotten, it is vinified by one of the true Burgundian masters.

2007 BOURGOGNE ROUGE • DOMAINE LUCIEN BOILLOT & FILS

We recently offered Pierre Boillot's full range of 2007 red Burgundies on prearrival, and we hope you got in on the fun. Our first shipment of Pierre's Bourgogne *rouge* just arrived, and it makes a great introduction to this domaine's house style. It is a blend of fruit from vineyards in Gevrey-Chambertin and Volnay, and while the Gevrey is dominant, the Volnay adds finesse both aromatically and on the palate. Again, you have the best of both worlds, the masculinity of Gevrey and the femininity of Volnay, all in one bottle of well-priced Pinot Noir, and that is worth your attention.

2007 MOREY-SAINT-DENIS "EN LA RUE DE VERGY" • DOMAINE RÉGIS BOUVIER

The acreage around the village Morey-Saint-Denis is quite distinguished, boasting a formidable concentration of *grand cru* vineyards. To generalize, the Morey style is somewhere between Chambolle and Gevrey, broader-shouldered than Chambolle but livelier and brighter than Gevrey. Bouvier applies his talent aptly in this great Morey vineyard, his only holding in the appellation. Every year he ages it a little longer in barrel than his other cuvées, and it is always well worth the wait. It is a Burgundy to enjoy now or hold for three to five years to achieve additional aromatic complexity and roundness of tannin.

SAVOIE TREASURES

2008 CHIGNIN • A. ET M. QUENARD

The first trip I took with Kermit this past summer was pretty epic in its scope. We started in Chablis and worked our way down through Burgundy, the Mâconnais, and Beaujolais before stopping in Savoie on our way to Italy, where we did a big circle from Piedmont to the Veneto to Tuscany to the Ligurian coast. We tasted a lot of great wines, so it wasn't necessarily an easy job for Michel Quenard's little white wine—a mountainside Jacquère from the village of Chignin—to make a lasting impression. But it did. Michel works hard and he aims to please. This little Chignin is as fresh a country quaffer as you'll find, with a touch less sparkle and a bit more juicy white peach than his Abymes bottling, and it begs immediate consumption. It might even freshen your outlook.

2008 CHIGNIN-BERGERON "LES TERRASSES" A. ET M. QUENARD

Same appellation as the above wine, totally different grape. It's hard to imagine two white grapes more different than Jacquère and Bergeron (the latter being the local name for Roussanne), yet these are both from the infinitesimal village of Chignin. Jacquère gives a pale-colored, low-alcohol, lively wine. Bergeron gives a golden-colored, ripe, and honeyed wine that is capable of aging. This particular bottling is from old vines planted on terraces built into the mountain-side behind the Quenard winery. It is extremely complex in aroma and flavor (I'll spare you my five adjectives for each) and destined for fine things at table.

2008 CHIGNIN MONDEUSE "VIEILLES VIGNES" A. ET M. QUENARD

Here is another Chignin, but this time a red one. "Mondeuse" is the name of the grape, which is genetically related to Refosco in northern Italy. It also vaguely resembles Syrah. Quenard works an old-vine parcel and ages the wine in old wooden *foudres*. It is dark brick in color with red fruits, tobacco, and sweet spices on the nose. I love the evolution on the palate—it starts commendably round and ripe, then the trademark tannin kicks in, bites, and wakes you up, then a soft, caressing finish. That's rare, folks.

THE MANY FACES OF PINOT BLANC

N THE HANDS OF TALENTED wine growers, I love Pinot Blanc, which finds its way into some of my favorite eclectic, under-the-radar white Burgundies such as Guillemot's Savigny *Blanc* and Chevillon's Nuits-Saint-Georges *Blanc*. For my palate, some of the most exciting expressions of the grape come from Alsace, no doubt thanks to the plethora of Pinot "Blanc" available to them. Read on.

2008 PINOT BLANC "BARRIQUES" DOMAINE OSTERTAG

This beauty from André Ostertag is a quartet of Pinots, combining traces of Pinot Auxerrois, Pinot Gris, and the *jus blanc* of Pinot Noir with the most *blanc* of Pinots. André is one of the Pinot masters of France, even if he doesn't live in Burgundy. He ages this wine in Burgundian barrels and it is fully dry, fleshy, and pure class, with a stimulating interplay between creamy and nervy impressions.

2008 PINOT BLANC "VIEILLES VIGNES" MEYER-FONNÉ

Félix Meyer has a similar strategy for his old-vines Pinot Blanc in terms of the blend, but he raises the wine in large wooden *foudres* for a more traditionally Alsatian take on the grape. A beautiful wine with smoky minerality, bright acidity, and a supple texture, this makes my short list of versatile whites to always have on hand. I also believe it is one of our best values in white wine.

2008 PINOT BIANCO • LA VIARTE

Giulio Ceschin at La Viarte is a purist when it comes to varietals, so this is a straight-up Pinot Bianco. La Viarte's vineyards were carved out of a mountain-side on the Italian/Slovenian border by Giulio's father and have their own unique microclimate. Giulio prefers to raise his Pinot Bianco in stainless steel, going for a clean, precise expression. His 2008 is very fresh and also fleshy, with a grind on the white pepper mill. It is delicious with Italian antipasti—can't you feel your mouth water a bit imagining this with some freshly sliced salumi and dry ricotta?

2008 LANGHE NEBBIOLO • SILVIO GIAMELLO

This bottling from Silvio Giamello is really a baby Barbaresco. It is made from fruit entirely sourced in the Barbaresco appellation. Silvio selects and vinifies apart certain batches that show more forward character, bottling them separately. That way we get to enjoy and preview the new vintage while the remainder of the Barbaresco sits in *botti* in his cellar in Piedmont slowly maturing.

2005 BAROLO "LAZZAIRASCO" GUIDO PORRO

Kermit and I visited Guido this past summer, and I've never been so impressed during a cellar tasting of young Barolo from cask. It can be a tough customer, but at Guido's place it always comes around. His 2007s were already so charming I couldn't believe it. After the barrel tasting, it is always a pleasure to shift to the older, bottled wine, where you see the full picture. The 2005 vintage made quite an impression, and we quickly put some on a boat Berkeley-bound. This is the real thing, textbook Barolo, almost as rare today as true claret. Drink it now after several hours in the decanter or lay it away for as long as you can wait. And the price is not a typo.

2006 CHIANTI CLASSICO "RISERVA" VILLA DI GEGGIANO

The Bandinelli brothers produced a very classy reserve wine in 2006, an observation that would come as no surprise if you had dined with Andrea and Alessandro at their villa in Tuscany. They run a class A operation from stem to stern. Geggiano ages their best Sangiovese in wood in a tiny, vaulted cellar beneath their 16th-century villa near Siena. This produces their Chianti Riserva, which in 2006 is quite rich and sumptuous with a killer texture, the tannins fine yet gripping. Geggiano's Riserva is delicious upon release, thanks to the extended bottle aging it has already received in their cellars, but we recommend continuing to age some in your cellars for maximum reward. If you buy a case, drink a bottle a year.

VALUES OF THE MONTH

2007 MÂCON-VILLAGES • HENRI PERRUSSET

Henri Perrusset is a rarity in the sea of *cooperatives* and *négociants* who dominate the Mâcon market today. Mâcon can be special, can show personality and character. Perrusset farms a few small parcels of hillside vines in the northernmost slice of Mâconnais limestone. We are proud to represent small French farmers like him. These days, our purchases literally keep them in business, as the French government would just as soon regulate them out of existence. We often hear the complaint that Henri's Mâcon is a little more expensive than some of the other Mâcons available, but just remember that you make a choice when you purchase this wine—it supports a way of life and a tradition of agriculture that the United States itself is rightly starting to re-embrace as it recognizes the damage done by agribusiness. But we wouldn't even ask you to make the choice if we didn't think the wine was worth every cent and more. No, we think this is a worthy bottle of white Burgundy and we're confident you'll agree.

2008 VIN DE PAYS DES COLLINES RHODANIENNES "SYRAH" • PHILIPPE FAURY

Philippe Faury's vineyards are located in the northern fringe of Syrah country in the Rhône Valley, near the town of Ampuis. Faury is a Syrah specialist known for his outstanding Saint Joseph *rouge*, and his Syrah has a character similar to the wines of nearby Côte Rôtie. These are Syrahs of great finesse, loaded with perfume. Out of nowhere, Philippe presented us with this Vin de Pays, made from a few of his vineyards just outside the Saint Joseph appellation. We were awed but not at all surprised by the quality, the pure pleasure, of this gorgeous bottle of wine. This is a very strong contender for Value of the Year in red wine from KLWM.
