2007 CORBIÈRES
“RÉSERVE LA DEMOISELLE”
DOMAINE DE FONTSAINTE

STANDING ON A DIRT ROAD overlooking La Demoiselle, the more-than-one-hundred-year-old Carignan vineyard owned by Domaine de Font-sainte, I turned in the opposite direction and suddenly thought I was back in California during wildfire season: a scarred landscape as far as the eye could see, with the withered remains of several vineyards burnt beyond recognition.

“My god, what happened here?” I asked Bruno Laboucaricé, the winemaker at Domaine de Font-sainte.

“A lightning storm,” he said. “It scorched over 2,400 acres. Lucky for us, the fire stopped at the road where you’re standing and spared our vineyard.”

Lucky for us, indeed.

The inspiration for this story of my visit to Corbières was a bottle of the 2001 Domaine de Font-sainte Réserve La Demoiselle I had recently with friends. Without great expectations, I was simply astounded by how well-preserved the wine was. The dark fruit aromas were so fresh; the texture was like velvet, and the smell of the *garrigue*—the herb and scrub brush of the Languedoc—was so pronounced, I felt like I was standing in the vineyards with Bruno again. Considering the small price I paid when I purchased it (a whopping \$14.95), I couldn’t ask for a better return on my investment.

In my excitement after drinking the 2001 Demoiselle, I realized that I had to spread the gospel of this amazing wine. To experience this wine aged, at its peak, and be completely blown away by its quality versus cost—isn’t that what great wine drinking is all about?

Here is a golden opportunity for you. We have a good supply sent recently from France of the 2007 Domaine de Font-sainte Réserve La Demoiselle, an incredible vintage in the Languedoc and quite similar to 2001. The beauty of La Demoiselle is that it does drink well young, but please be patient, because the benefits you’ll receive with five to ten years of age are enormous. In fact, that’s the best route to take with the wine—twelve or more bottles to drink over twelve or more years.

This could be a brilliant gift idea for Christmas. Include a note if you wish: “Age this beauty five to ten years.” Just don’t miss out purchasing, in my opinion, the greatest value our portfolio has to offer—an extraordinary wine at a painless price.

ANDRÉ OSTERTAG

Oh André, hats off to you for your current collection. Tasting them, I wondered, were you feeling the effects of the recession, so you went to work and made even better wines to grab our attention?

As Ravier and I sniffed and tasted, we were not blasé. We were blown away. When we finished, he asked if he could take the leftovers home to show off and share with his wife.

2009 PINOT BLANC "BARRIQUES"

This bottling has been a favorite for years and the '09 is the best version ever. Full, fine, and flavorful—what a treat!

2008 MUSCAT "FRONHOLZ"

2008 PINOT GRIS "FRONHOLZ"

Here are two of the reasons to take this one home. First, it shows the good stuff that earned vintage 2009 such rave reviews from wine critics. Second, it is one of the finest dry Vouvrays of my career, and I've had some beauties. The nose has real depth and announces that you have something abnormally good in your glass. Notice that little tinge of apricot pit—yum! Then it slowly leaves your palate happily saturated with mineral, fruit, and floral flavors.

2009 VOUVRAY “LES TRIES DE VENDANGE” DOMAINE CHAMPALOU

In order to expand the staff's tasting experience, I uncorked it the other night alongside the domaine's stunning 1990. How long will the 2009 age? “We won't be around to know,” said Didier Champalou.

2008 CHINON “LA CROIX BOISSÉE” DOMAINE BERNARD BAUDRY

The vineyard is named “the wooden cross,” because drinking wine from its vines is a religious experience. The real miracle awaits those of you with cellars, because this is a Chinon to hide away until some special occasion when only a great red will suffice. You'll be glad you saved some.

2009 CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE “L’ÉLÉMENTAIRE” DOMAINE GRAMENON

One goes to Gramenon for a lesson in just how wonderful a Côtes-du-Rhône can be.

First, take a look. The color is gorgeous, as vivid as wine can be. And the aroma of juicy grapes is exquisite—classy juicy Grenache grapes. Then revel in those tannins—so thick and voluptuous as they sink into your palate.

I imagine pouring this one up at a picnic table in Tilden Park with barbecued whatever: chops, burgers, sausages, red peppers, eggplants, and . . . like that!

2008 NOWAT • DUPÉRÉ BARRERA

This red is from the Côtes-de-Provence appellation. If you can find one better, I predict that it, too, will have been produced by Dupéré and Barrera.

NOWAT! Look, Ma, no watts—yes, a wine made without the use of electricity. And no, it is not a gimmick. This is how wine was made for centuries. Chew that around in your head while you gnaw on the wine itself.

It is an eloquent red, loaded with the fruits, herbs, and spices of Provence—a tasting experience not to be missed.

2009 PATRIMONIO BLANC “HAUT DE CARCO” ANTOINE ARENA

Haut de Carco is Arena’s pride and joy, a vineyard he planted on a Patrimonio hillside surrounded by majestic peaks and the awesome blue Mediterranean. Well, most of Patrimonio could be described in the same words, but Haut de Carco is from the highest slope and a stony, decomposed oyster shell soil which gives the Vermentino a depth and balance that reminds me of Meursault. Of course the flavors are not from Meursault. The 2009 has discreet fruit, limestone complexity and finesse, great length, and the perfume of the surrounding maquis in bloom.

Will it age? I don’t care. I enjoy it now. To my taste buds, it is one of the top dry whites in the store at any price right now.

2008 CORNAS

AUGUSTE CLAPE

KERMIT JUST WROTE ME after tasting some samples of the 2008 Clape Cornas that I brought back from my recent trip to the Rhône Valley. “It’s a perfect vintage, the Cornas I grew up on before global warming.” As recently as 1990, a vigneron in Cornas told Kermit that he had never seen such high alcohol in a wine—at only 12.8 degrees! It really brought home the point that the fabled, dark, chewy, inky wine of Cornas is not all about overripe fruit or high alcohol. This is the real deal, folks, classic northern Rhône Syrah, Syrah that couldn’t come from anywhere else. That’s why we go all the way to Cornas to buy it for you (and some for ourselves, *bien sûr*). Clape’s flagship Cornas bottling contains three of the best Syrah vineyards in the world: Reynards, La Côte, and Les Sabarottes (purchased from Noël Verset).

THIERRY ALLEMAND

THIERRY ALLEMAND was on point in 2008, as one might expect, with two Cornas cuvées of impressive depth and purity and, of course, classic *goût de terroir*. I also discussed the phenomenon of rising alcohol levels in Cornas with Thierry, and he described how he is changing the way he works the soil and the pruning of his vines in order to increase yields slightly to lessen the alcohol content. He fabricates all of his own metal hand-plows in the garage underneath his house in Cornas. A truly self-sufficient vigneron, he doesn’t count on anyone but himself to supply the tools for success.

His old-vine Reynard bottling is the stuff of legend—a dark, chewy, gamey, leathery, bloody, granitic Syrah masterpiece. Chaillot has more charm and drinks well earlier.

ARTISANAL SAUTERNES

WHY ARTISANAL? Well, is it from one of those pricey classified châteaux owned by an insurance company or giant corporation and vinified by a recent enology school graduate? NO.

Knowing what I know now, what would I change about my personal wine cellar? Back in the early seventies there was plenty of great and even aged Sauternes for sale, including Yquem. We all imagined it would always be so. Plus, I was broke. Back then I'd have to save up just to buy a two-buck harmonica. Anyway, I didn't cellar enough Sauternes.

Yes, Sauternes, a glorious creation with its noble rot. Instead of The Roaches, why did I not name my band Noble Rot? On my tombstone, please: "What rot, of the noblest variety." (Just kidding, Gail.)

Come along—it's easy. You cellar half-bottles, which age well enough besides being handy. I uncorked a tenth of 1977 Yquem last year that was just the right size for my wife and me—about two glasses each—and it had aged in quite a positive manner. I like Sauternes with foie gras, truffles, and Fourme d'Ambert (a mild blue cheese), for example, but mainly I like it as dessert—it, the tenth of Sauternes, being the dessert, not served *with* a dessert.

I have two tenths to recommend. They are both from Hervé Dubourdieu and his ultra-noble-rot *terroir*. Hervé is out there harvesting his grapes and he makes the wine. "Knowing which grapes to include is 98% of making a great Sauternes," he says.

2006 CHÂTEAU ROÛMIEU-LACOSTE

Nothing less than perfect and it thoroughly expresses what is lovable about Sauternes. It is pure and classic and there is a wonderful "facility" to it.

From an old-vine parcel bordering Climens—Hervé named the bottling after one of his two sons. It seems more penetrating and forceful—more *roti* in the aroma, too.
